Yesterday the undersigned met with Ruth Milkman, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and James Schlichting, Senior Deputy Bureau Chief. I discussed Verizon Wireless's July 22, 2009 letter to the Honorable Henry Waxman, Chairman, House Energy and Commerce Committee, supporting a new statute or FCC rule governing home roaming if it applied to all carriers. (The letter was previously filed in these dockets on July 23, 2009.) I reiterated the company's position as set forth in the letter that the Commission should reject efforts to require in-market roaming on an individual carrier basis.
