Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 10, 2009, Bill Morrow, Chief Executive Officer, Cathleen Massey, VP Regulatory & Public Policy and Chris Murray, VP External Affairs, met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and Renée Roland Crittendon, Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Advisor.

During the meeting, the participants generally discussed Clearwire's recent rollout of its 4G WiMAX network in Portland, OR, Las Vegas, NV and Atlanta, GA and its publicly announced plans for deploying service in additional markets. In addition, as noted in its comments in this proceeding, Clearwire discussed its commitment to operating a network based upon an open platform that permits consumers to bring their choice of applications and devices to the network. Clearwire also discussed wholesale arrangements with other carriers as a method for extending 4G services to more consumers. Finally, the parties discussed the history of the development of competitive wireless services in the United Kingdom and Japan based upon Mr. Morrow's business experience in those countries.
