This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on September 15, 2009, Ben Scott, Derek Turner, and Chris Riley of Free Press met with Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis.

We discussed issues pertaining to the Commission's ongoing responsibility to promote diversity in broadcast ownership, including the current status of the Commission's rules in light of ongoing appellate court activity. Our presentation was consistent with our numerous filings in Docket Nos. 06-121 and 07-294. We further discussed issues related to data collection at the FCC, including in particular the Commission's open expedited proceeding concerning Form 477 data collection. Our presentation was consistent with our past filings in Docket No. 07-38. We discussed issues related to the Commission's current work in developing its report on the state of competition in the markets for video programming distribution services and for commercial mobile services, and our presentations were consistent with past filings in Docket Nos. 07-269 and 09-66.
