On September 23, 2009, Bohdan Pyskir, President, LEMKO Corporation and I, outside counsel to LEMKO, met with Stagg Newman, Tom Koutsky, and B.J. Neal of the FCC's Broadband Deployment team, and Charles Mathias of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-referenced proceeding. We also met separately with David Goldman, acting legal advisor to Chairman Genachowski, and Erin McGrath, acting legal advisor to Commissioner Baker. In addition, on September 24, Mr. Pyskir and Ari Fitzgerald of Hogan & Hartson met separately with Angela Giancarlo, legal advisor to Commissioner McDowell, and Jennifer Schneider, legal advisor to Commissioner Copps.

In these meetings, we discussed issues raised in the attached presentation related to LEMKO's 4<sup>th</sup> generation core network platform, including the economics of serving unserved and underserved rural areas and potential obstacles (such as spectrum access and roaming) to providing service in rural areas.
