Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 01, 2009, Jesse Caulfield, President and CEO, Key Bridge Global LLC met with Jamila Bess Johnson, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael J. Copps.

The parties discussed the unlicensed operation in the television broadcast bands ("TV White Space").

In the meeting we discussed Key Bridge's assessment of the underlying business goals and concerns of various industry groups and the benefits of a neutral TV bands database administrator. Topics covered in the conversation included variants in potential TV bands database system architecture and differences of opinion with regard to device security. We also discussed Key Bridge's estimation of critical-path items necessary for a sustainable TV bands ecosystem that serves to maximize unlicensed adoption while ensuring incumbent protection.

Key Bridge is a Virginia company and candidate for FCC authorization to operate a TV bands database. We have provided a number of contributions and suggestions to help to move the process forward including market analysis, open system architecture, methods and practices plus commercial transaction models and security framework. Our solution is neutral, standards based, extensible and implements a TV bands database that:

- Protects incumbent services;
- Publishes unlicensed availability on a non-discriminatory basis;
- Maximizes consumer convenience and transparency
