Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 01, 2009, Jesse Caulfield, President and CEO, Key Bridge Global LLC met with the following representatives of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau: Monica Desai, Deputy Bureau Chief, Paul E. Murray, Assistant Bureau Chief, Matthew Nodine, Chief of Staff; and the following representatives of the Office of Engineering & Technology: Julius Knapp, Chief; Alan Stillwell, Deputy Chief; and Hugh Van Tuyl, Senior Electronics Engineer.

The parties discussed unlicensed operation in the television broadcast bands ("TV White Space"). In the meeting we presented Key Bridge's proposed open architecture template for a TV bands database, the status of internal and external dependencies, and a progress update of our system and software development. We also discussed how information might be effectively consolidated and reported back to the FCC, plus Key Bridge's estimation of critical-path items necessary for a sustainable TV bands ecosystem that serves to maximize unlicensed adoption while ensuring incumbent protection.

Key Bridge is a Virginia company and candidate for FCC authorization to operate a TV bands database. We have contributed a number of suggestions that may help to move the docket forward including market analysis, architecture, methods and practices plus commercial transaction models and security framework. Our solution is neutral, standards based, extensible and implements a TV bands database that:

- Protects incumbent services;
- Publishes unlicensed availability on a non-discriminatory basis;
- Maximizes consumer convenience and transparency
