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


Resurrection Lutheran School has been in existence for over 50 years. It presently serves students in grades pre-kindergarten to sixth. It has four teachers and a part-time principal. Volunteers are recruited to help with the curriculum and everyday responsibilities of running a dedicated educational and Christian program. The school presently has federal funding for Title I Programs at 76%. It is located in a community of public and mixed-income housing. The school endeavors to offer a number of opportunities to our students that would otherwise not be available.

During the stages of securing E-Rate funding for the children at Resurrection Lutheran School, numerous attempts were made to rectify any omissions including calls to various individual responsible for issuing approval letters for Technology Plans. Contact was made with Donna Braband, Director for Schools, who informed us that she was not available to approve Technology Plans until November of that year. Contacts were made with Rick Opperman, Technology Consultant (Northern Illinois District LCMS School) who is listed as an Alternate contact. Contacts were made with Beth Adams, ISBE Tech Supports; Joe Boehle, ISBE contact to submit Technology Plans and to Reed Sanders, NID Mission Facilitator. None of the individuals listed above gave Resurrection the needed assistance. We are therefore, appealing your decision to recover funding for the 2005 Funding Year.

As the Principal and responsible person at Resurrection Lutheran School, I would like to express my regrets for not coordinating and directing this situation to a more desirable conclusion during a transition period. It was my responsibility to have offered the administrative leadership in securing this necessary document. While there was no criminal intent or misappropriation of funds involved in this oversight (The classroom, etc. are wired, the equipment is here and internet access is available in this building.), an omission was involved. I totally accept my professional shortfall and pray that the CHILDREN WILL NOT HAVE TO SUFFER BECAUSE OF ME.
