On behalf of QUALCOMM Incorporated (“QUALCOMM”), this is to report that yesterday, October 7, 2009, Dr. Paul Jacobs, Donald Rosenberg, Peggy Johnson, and I met with Chairman Julius Genachowski, Edward Lazarus, Bruce Gottlieb, Shomiq Dutta, and John Leibovitz (collectively, the “FCC Staff”). During the course of the meeting, we presented the FCC Staff with information, and answered the FCC Staff’s questions, concerning various wide area wireless technologies, including the 3G technologies, LTE, and MediaFLO, all of which are also described in QUALCOMM’s filings in the above-referenced proceedings. Likewise, the views we expressed during the meeting on issues before the Commission, including the need for the Commission to identify, allocate, and auction a considerable amount of licensed spectrum to meet the substantial and constant growth in demand for mobile broadband, and the need to allow wireless carriers to manage their networks in light of the limited bandwidth, and limited spectrum, on which those networks operate, are contained in QUALCOMM’s filings in the above-referenced proceedings.
