



Re: Certification of Support for Rural and Non-Rural High-Cost Carriers Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Sections 54.313-314, CC Docket Nos. 96-45 and 00-256.

This certification is filed in accordance with Title 47, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Sections 54.313 and 54.314. The California Public Utilities Commission certifies that WWC License LLC, d/b/a Alltel Communications LLC, Study Area Code 549006, is eligible to receive federal universal service high-cost support pursuant to 47 CFR Sections 54.313, 54.314. However, WWC License is only eligible to receive federal universal service high-cost support for the areas of Inyo and Mono Counties. WWC relinquished their ETC designation for Imperial County effective July 9, 2009 by resolution T-17188.

The federal universal high-cost support received will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended.
