COMMENTS

Gray Television Licensee, LLC ("Gray"), licensee of Station WKYT-TV ("WKYT"), Lexington, Kentucky, by counsel hereby submits its Comments in the above-captioned proceeding. In response to a Petition for Rulemaking filed by Gray on August 21, 2009, the Commission released a Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("NPRM") proposing the substitution of DTV channel 36 for channel 13 at Lexington, Kentucky.¹ Gray hereby reaffirms its interest in the proposed channel substitution. As outlined in its Petition for Rule Making, the channel substitution serves the public interest by resolving significant reception problems in certain areas of WKYT's predicted service area, bringing consistency to the market as all other stations in this market broadcast on a UHF channel, and improving the possibility for service to viewers using hand-held and mobile devices.


