Brian Rankin and Beth Choroser participated in the meeting by telephone. In the course of the meeting, Comcast reiterated the views set forth in its comments in response to the Broadband Plan Notice of Inquiry regarding reform of the universal service high cost fund. Comcast also reiterated its support for a uniform pole attachment fee set at the current amount assessed to cable television attachments. Comcast's comments were consistent with the written comments previously submitted in the above-referenced proceedings.
