Dear Ms. Dortch,

This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on October 15, 2009, Ben Scott and Chris Riley of Free Press met with Commissioner Meredith Attwell Baker, Christi Shewman, and Charles Mathias.

We discussed issues related to the Network Neutrality. In particular, we discussed the challenges to network management posed by variations in Internet access service technologies. Free Press presented our position that uniform open Internet rules applied to all technologies can adequately accommodate the needs of different platforms through a framework of reasonable network management. We also discussed the relationship between open Internet rules and the possibility of offering so-called "managed" services within this framework, and Free Press presented our position that such services should not be permitted to undermine the open Internet by enabling anticompetitive or anti-consumer behavior.
