Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise that yesterday, October 21<sup>st</sup>, the undersigned and Danny Hankins, Secretary, Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council ("AFTRCC"), had a telephone conversation with John Kennedy of the Office of Engineering & Technology. The purpose of the call was to report that as of yesterday's date, there was a total of fifty-five (55) flight test telemetry receive sites for which AFTRCC has a set of coordinates and which operate in the band 2360-2370 MHz. It was pointed out that this number reflected Non-Government sites only, and does not include mobile telemetry assets deployed to variable locations. The AFTRCC representatives also called Mr. Kennedy's attention to the fact that, since the Commission does not license receive sites but only transmit sites, data residing in the Universal Licensing System is not reflective of receive antenna locations. Finally, the AFTRCC representatives advised that the number referenced above is subject to change as new facilities are deployed.

A copy of this ex parte statement is being submitted for the record in above-referenced proceedings.
