

If the proposed rules are adopted, network providers will have no competitive advantage in providing Internet based applications and the cost of network access will increase. In most areas there are now multiple providers (satellite, cable, DSL, WiMax and cellular) capable of providing network access. These providers have invested considerably in their networks and did not do so solely to provide "dumb pipes". It is clear they have developed their networks to provide "applications" and should not be required to undermine their own services for the sake of competitors that have not made any network investment. I encourage you to let the market best determine the outcome.
