

I am a community radio advocate. I support more broadcast station ownership for minorities, women, and the handicapped.

I was involved in the low power FM cause from the beginning. My first LPFM petition was in the 1980's

This is important. We can't move LPFM to a new toy FM band of 70 MHz. There are no receivers for this band. People aren't going to be able to listen if we create this new toy radio band.

In addition there will be less not more AM listeners if the stations are moved to 80MHz.

Internet radio is now being installed in cars. RM-11565 is 20 years too late.

I support relaxing the 2nd and 3rd adjacency requirements for LPFM. I support the concept of Low Power AM. I am for expanding the FM band below 88 MHz.

Forcing LPFM to move to 70 MHz will kill LPFM. Forcing the people to buy new radios to listen will harm broadcasting. This idea is 20 years too late.
