This letter provides notice that on October 27, 2009, Jaime Harrison, Peggy Binzel and Cathy Rought of the Podesta Group, Joe Kochan of DigitalBridge Communications, and Jennifer McCarthy of NextWave Wireless Inc. met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and legal advisor Carol Simpson regarding the above captioned proceeding in which changes are proposed to the technical rules governing both SDARS and WCS to enable coexistence of the two services.

The parties discussed the history of the WCS-SDARS rulemaking proceeding, including the joint testing conducted this past summer by the WCS Coalition with Sirius XM and the Commissioner's Office of Engineering and Technology, which demonstrated the ability of both services to operate without harmful interference under the rules proposed by the WCS Coalition. The parties also discussed the importance of bringing this longstanding rulemaking to a conclusion as quickly as possible to enable WCS licensees to move forward with mobile broadband deployments and meet their substantial service obligations.
