





**JOINT APPLICATION FOR STREAMLINED APPROVAL
OF ASSIGNMENT OF ASSETS**

Wellman Cooperative Telephone Association (“WCTA”), and Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc. d/b/a Iowa Telecom (“Iowa Telecom”) (collectively, the “Applicants”), by their attorneys, hereby request approval pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ and Sections 63.03 and 63.04 of the Commission’s rules,² for the transfer of one access line from Iowa Telecom to WCTA. This application is subject to streamlined processing under Section 63.03(b)(1)(iii) of the Commission’s rules because it involves only the transfer of the local exchange assets of an incumbent local exchange carrier (“LEC”) by means other than an acquisition of corporate control.³

As described in this application, Iowa Telecom has agreed to transfer a single access line served by Iowa Telecom in its Williamsburg, Iowa exchange to WCTA. After the transaction is complete, WCTA will thereafter provide local, intrastate, and interstate telecommunications services to the customer served by the transferred line as part of the Wellman, Iowa Exchange. The Parties have filed a Joint Petition for Waiver of the definition of "study area" contained in the Appendix-Glossary of Part 36 of the Commission's rules to permit Iowa Telecom to transfer a limited area in the Williamsburg exchange containing the subject access line, and to allow WCTA to add that area to the Wellman exchange. In support of this Application, Applicants submit the following information pursuant to Section 63.04 of the Commission's rules:

- (4) **The name, address, citizenship and principal business of any person or entity that directly or indirectly owns at least ten (10) percent of the equity of the applicant, and the percentage of equity owned by each of these entities (to the nearest one (1) percent).**

Iowa Telecom: Not applicable. Iowa Telecom is a widely-held, publicly traded corporation that is primarily engaged in the provision of telecommunications services to the public. To the best of its

knowledge, no single party holds a 10 percent or greater interest in Iowa Telecom.

WCTA: Not Applicable. WCTA is a telephone cooperative, and no single party holds a 10 percent or greater interest in WCTA.

Iowa Telecom and WCTA certify, pursuant to Sections 1.2001 through 1.2003 of the Commission's rules, that neither party is subject to a denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 853.

(6) **Description of the Transaction:**

A. Background.

Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., headquartered in Newton, Iowa, began business on June 30, 2000, when it acquired the Iowa operations of GTE Midwest Incorporated ("GTE"). Today, Iowa Telecom is a publicly-traded company (NYSE:IWA) with \$832 million in assets as of June 30, 2009 and approximately \$240 million in annual revenue.⁴

Iowa Telecom operates 288 telephone exchanges in Iowa as the ILEC. Through its subsidiaries Iowa Telecom Communications, Inc. and IT Communications, LLC, Iowa Telecom serves as a CLEC in all exchanges in Iowa in which Qwest is the ILEC. Iowa Telecom also serves ten exchanges in Minnesota as the ILEC through its Lakedale Telephone Company subsidiary. Further, Iowa Telecom currently serves 104 exchanges in Minnesota as the CLEC through its Lakedale Link, Inc. and Lakedale Link, LLC subsidiaries and majority-owned EN-

TEL Communications, LLC subsidiary.⁵ Both Iowa Telecom and Lakedale Telephone Company are ILECs, which have in combination fewer than two percent of the nation's subscriber lines installed in the aggregate nationwide, and no overlapping or adjacent service areas with each other.⁶

As of June 30, 2009, Iowa Telecom served approximately 236,000 access lines in Iowa and Minnesota, including approximately 203,200 access lines as the ILEC. Also as of that date, Iowa Telecom was the presubscribed long distance provider on approximately 143,200 of its lines, served approximately 79,000 digital subscriber line ("DSL") customers,⁷ and served approximately 14,000 dial-up Internet customers.⁸ Iowa Telecom resells EchoStar's DISH Network satellite video service to its local exchange customers. Iowa Telecom's mobile wireless operations consist entirely of the resale operations of its Minnesota subsidiary Lakedale Communications, LLC, and of its subsidiary, Montezuma Mutual Telephone Company, in such subsidiary's two-exchange Iowa ILEC territory.⁹

WTCA is an independent telephone company that provides local exchange telecommunications services in the Wellman exchange, which is comprised of approximately 1,286 access lines. WTCA is an average schedule company, and it is an issuing carrier in the

NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. WTCA is a participant in the NECA carrier common line and traffic sensitive pools.

B. The transaction that is the subject of this application.

WCTA has provided service to a customer in the Wellman exchange since December 1997 on an adjacent exchange basis. That customer has requested an additional access line, and has expressed a desire to continue to receive service from the Wellman exchange. Accordingly, Petitioners have entered into an asset purchase agreement to transfer a very small area (only 1/4 sq. miles) from the Williamsburg exchange to the Wellman exchange, which will result in the transfer of one access line from Iowa Telecom to WCTA. Upon receipt of all necessary regulatory approvals, and after closing the transaction with Iowa Telecom, WCTA will provide service to the acquired access line as the incumbent local exchange carrier. The transaction therefore involves only the transfer of the local exchange assets of an incumbent LEC by means other than acquisition of corporate control.¹⁰

WCTA will continue the provision of a full range of telecommunications services to the one customer affected by the transaction without any interruption to the current services provided to subscribers by Iowa Telecom. WCTA will offer services to the transferred customer at the same rates as those currently available to WCTA's customers in the Wellman exchange. No subscribers will lose their access to local exchange service as a result of the transfer. Moreover, since the transfer of the affected customer to WCTA's services is intended to occur automatically, after notice, the transition will be free of service disruptions.

On May 19, 2009, the Iowa Utilities Board ("IUB or "Board") issued an order approving Applicants' request to amend their exchange boundary maps to transfer the subject access line

from the Williamsburg to the Wellman exchange.¹¹ In the order, the Board determined that the request was reasonable because the boundary revision was initiated by the request of an individual seeking service from WCTA, and that no other customers would be affected by the change. By issuing the approval, the Board demonstrated that it does not object to the transfer

(7) Description of the geographic areas in which the transferor and transferee (and their affiliates) offer domestic telecommunications services, and what services are provided in each area.

The area being transferred covers a very small area – approximately 1/4 sq. miles, and it is located in a rural, sparsely populated section of east central Iowa. A map depicting the transferred area containing the access line being transferred from Iowa Telecom to WCTA is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Iowa Telecom is an independent ILEC headquartered in Newton, Iowa. Iowa Telecom currently provides local exchange and exchange access service, and other telecommunications services throughout the state of Iowa. WCTA is an independent ILEC headquartered in Wellman, Iowa. WCTA currently provides local exchange and exchange access service, and other telecommunications services to the Wellman, Iowa community.

(8) A statement as to how the application fits into one or more of the presumptive streamlined categories in Section 63.03 or why it is otherwise appropriate for streamlined treatment.

This transaction qualifies for presumptive streamlined treatment because it “involves only the transfer of the local exchange assets of an incumbent LEC by means other than an acquisition of control.”¹² As described above, the only asset involved in the transaction is a small 1/4 sq. mile area containing a single access line in the Williamsburg exchange. That area and the access

line will be transferred to WCTA, and no corporate change of control will result from the transaction.

(9) Identification of all other Commission applications related to the same transaction.

The parties have filed a joint petition with the Commission seeking (1) a waiver of the definition of “study area” contained in the Appendix-Glossary of Part 36 of the Commission’s rules, and (2) a waiver of the definition of “average schedule company” contained in Section 69.605(c) of the Commission’s rules. The Petition also requests a waiver, to the extent necessary, of Section 54.305 of the Commission’s rules regarding the payment of universal service support to WCTA. The Petition seeks FCC authority to remove the area containing the subject access line from Iowa Telecom’s current Iowa study area, and to add it to WCTA’s existing study area, which is comprised of the Wellman exchange. The Petition is currently pending before the Commission.

(10) A statement of whether the applicants are requesting special consideration because either party to the transaction is facing imminent business failure.

Neither of the Applicants is facing imminent business failure. Accordingly, no special consideration of this application on this ground is requested.

(11) Identification of any separately filed waiver requests being sought in conjunction with the transaction.


As discussed above, Iowa Telecom and WCTA have filed a joint petition with the Commission seeking a waiver of the definition of “study area” and “average schedule company”, and to the extent necessary, Section 54.305 of the Commission’s rules. The Petition is currently pending before the FCC.

- (12) **A statement showing how grant of the application will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity, including any additional information that may be necessary to show the effect of the proposed transaction on competition in domestic markets.**

Grant of the instant application will serve the public interest because it will result in the provision of high-quality telecommunications services to a rural consumer by the customer's carrier of choice. Moreover, it will result in direct benefits to the customer requesting to be served by WCTA. Specifically, the transferred customer has requested an additional access line, and desires to obtain that line from WCTA. WCTA intends to install and/or upgrade the equipment necessary to provide the additional access line to the transferred customer. Moreover, WCTA will continue the provision of excellent service quality and customer service to that customer, and it will provide such service at affordable and competitive prices. WCTA's management team will endeavor to ensure that all of its customers continue to receive the high-quality services they are accustomed to receiving, and WCTA will seek to bring innovative and technologically advanced services to subscribers as market conditions warrant. Accordingly, grant of the instant study area waiver request is in the public interest, and should be granted.

Conclusion

For the reasons stated herein, Iowa Telecom and WCTA respectfully request that the Commission apply presumptive streamlined processing to this Application pursuant to Section 63.03 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.03, and upon due consideration of the facts before it, issue an order approving the Application.



AREA BOUNDARY MAP




