This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on October 28, 2009, Ben Scott of Free Press met with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff to Chairman Julius Genachowski.

We discussed issues related to the Commission's recently released Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on Preserving the Open Internet. In general, my presentation was consistent with our filings on Network Neutrality in Docket 07-52, along with relevant portions of our Comments and Reply Comments concerning the National Broadband Plan filed on June 8 and July 21 in Docket No. 09-51. In particular, I emphasized the importance of a strong nondiscrimination principle with broad application as well as the necessity of a firm set of criteria against which to evaluate whether network management practices are reasonable.
