Also attending the meeting were Christina Clearwater, Nese Guendelsberger, Paul Murray, and Peter Trachtenberg of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

In this meeting, the Competitive Carrier Group representatives discussed the status of the pending petitions for reconsideration in WT Docket No. 05-265; the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in that docket pertaining to the extension of an automatic roaming requirement to wireless data services; and the status of petitions of reconsideration or clarification pending in WT Docket No. 08-95. The Competitive Carrier Group representatives also reiterated the substance of their respective positions of record in these dockets, including with respect to the

need for the Commission to eliminate the in-market exception to the automatic roaming obligation set forth in Section 20.12 of the Commission's Rules, and the need for the Commission to proceed to extend the automatic roaming obligation to data services.
