We discussed issues related to the Commission's recently released Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on Preserving the Open Internet. I emphasized the importance of a strong nondiscrimination principle with broad application as well as the necessity of a firm set of criteria against which to evaluate whether network management practices are reasonable. The details of these comments were consistent with the attached policy brief.
