**SUPPLEMENT TO COMMENTS
OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION AND
THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

On July 27, 2009, the California Public Utilities Commission and the People of the State of California (CPUC or California) submitted comments in the above-captioned proceeding on the Supplement to Petition to Mandate Captioned Telephone Relay Service.¹ One of the issues in the CPUC's comments concerned the issue of privacy in the CPUC's Request for Proposal (RFP) for a new relay service contract. We stated in our comments that, because the statutes at issue required interpretation of the California Penal Code which is not within the jurisdiction of the CPUC, we sought an opinion from the Office of the California Attorney General (AG). Last month, the CPUC received an informal opinion from the AG's office, and the CPUC has authorized public release of the opinion. Accordingly, as stated in our comments, the CPUC is hereby providing the Federal Communications Commission with a copy of the informal opinion rendered by the California AG on the privacy issue.
