

When I lived in High Springs, FL, 10 miles from where I now live in the country, I received local news from Gainesville, FL. (WCJB) via satellite. Now I live in Fort White where many people can get WCJB with an outdoor antenna, (I am low and cannot) and no cable service is available. I pay Dish network an additional premium to receive my "local channels" and I get news from Jacksonville...approx. 100 miles away. I need to have access to my LOCAL news.
