This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on November 5, 2009, Ben Scott and Chris Riley of Free Press met with Charles Mathias, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Meredith Attwell Baker.

We discussed issues related to the Commission's open proceedings on wireless competition, truth-in-billing and disclosure of information concerning wireless and broadband Internet Access services, and preserving the open Internet. We reiterated arguments in our jointly filed comments and reply comments in docket 09-66 to emphasize the impact of roaming, early termination fees, special access, consolidation, and other factors on the state of competition in the wireless market. We discussed our suggestions, as filed in comments and reply comments in dockets 09-158, 98-170, and 04-36, for additional disclosure of information needed by consumers to ensure transparency in selecting and using wireless and Internet access services. We discussed our support for the application of rules to protect the open Internet to wireless access services, consistent with our past filings on network neutrality in Docket 07-52.
