On November 5, 2009, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs and Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA-The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”), along with Kathleen Ham of T-Mobile, met with Charles Mathias, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Meredith Attwell Baker.

During the meeting, the parties discussed CTIA’s Petition for Declaratory Ruling to Ensure Timely Siting Review,¹ the growing delays carriers are experiencing in local zoning action on applications and the importance of Commission relief to address the bottleneck of pending tower siting applications. The parties outlined CTIA’s request for a “shot clock” on local zoning authorities’ consideration of tower siting applications in recognition that timely deployment of wireless facilities is critical to ensuring consumers’ access to wireless broadband services.
