Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 6, 2009 I telephoned Austin Schlick, General Counsel of the Federal Communications Commission to respond to his inquiry made to all the participants of the October 29, 2009 meeting to discuss issues raised by the D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals' remand order in *American Bird Conservancy v. FCC*, 516 F.3d 1027 (D.C. Cir. 2008). Mr. Schlick had asked the participants whether they would be willing to participate in a second meeting, which would focus on interim procedures that could be integrated into the ASR process.

On behalf of the Infrastructure Coalition I responded that the Infrastructure Coalition is willing to share its views on what Interim Guidelines should govern the ASR process and to enter into good faith negotiations. I stated that we understand that location, lighting, height and ground support are among the topics that will be discussed. I indicated that the Infrastructure Coalition believes that interim guidelines must be streamlined, predictable and definite.
