

Ms. Dortch:

This letter serves as an appeal for assistance concerning a clerical mistake I made during the filing of funding requests for funding of internet access services on a two year contract with our internet provider, Licking Area Computer Association. For the above referenced 470 application I filed all submissions in a timely manner as required, but when I filed the funding year 2009 applications I was unaware that a 471 and 486 submission was required for a multi-year contract 470 that was filed during a prior year. I was not aware of this mistake until I received communication from Licking Area Computer Association inquiring as to why a 471 and 486 had not been filed. In no way did I purposely ignore this reporting requirement, but because of my mistake it appears that our school district will be denied over \$20,000 in assistance, which would be a more than major strain on our budget already weakened by other

state and federal cuts. I have filed an appeal with the Schools And Libraries Division and have received an Administrator's Decision letter, which is attached. I would greatly appreciate any assistance that the FCC can provide, as well as information on how I should proceed with this appeal.
