COMMENTS

Munbilla Broadcasting Properties, Ltd. (*MPBL*), by its communications counsel, hereby files its Comments in this proceeding.

I. BACKGROUND

A. THE PETITIONS

1. On August 12, 2009, MBPL filed a Petition for Rule Making asking the Commission to allot Channel 284A to Kingsland, Texas as a first local service. As required, MBPL also filed an FCC Form 301 application for a Construction Permit for Channel 284A at Kingsland, and paid the requisite filing fee.

2. On August 25, 2009, Katherine Pyeatt filed a Petition for Rule Making. Ms. Pyeatt's Petition also asks the FCC to allot Channel 284A to Kingsland, Texas as a first local service. As required, Ms. Pyeatt also filed an FCC Form 301 application for a Construction Permit for Channel 284A at Kingsland, and paid the requisite filing fee.

B. THE NPRM

3. On October 23, 2009, the Commission released a Notice of Proposed Rule Making, DA 09-2269, proposing to allot Channel 284A to Kingsland. The NPRM set December 14, 2009, as the deadline for Comments. The Appendix to the NPRM, at Para. 2, called upon MBPL to file comments, at a minimum resubmitting or incorporating by reference its former pleadings. The Appendix to the NPRM, at Para. 2, also called upon MBPL to restate its present intention to apply for the channel if the channel is allotted and, if MBPL is so authorized, to build its proposed facility promptly.


II. COMMENTS

4. To fulfill the requirements of Para. 2 of the Appendix to the NPRM, MBPL hereby incorporates by reference the contents of its Petition for Rule Making, restating its present intention to apply for the channel if the channel is allotted. (In fact, MBPL has already filed such an application.) MBPL also restates its present intention to promptly construct the applied-for facility if the Commission authorizes MBPL to do so.

III. CONCLUSION

5. To further the public interest, the Commission should allot Channel 284A to Kingsland, Texas, as MBPL has requested.


