Dear Chairman Genachowski:

Thanks to two-plus decades of innovation wireless phones have undergone numerous transformations, from flip phones to smart phones, all while spurring economic productivity and allowing businesses to thrive in the digital economy.

While much progress has been made, the FCC's new focus on wireless network neutrality causes me great concern, because of the negative consequences for investment, innovation and jobs in Connecticut.

Regulating wireless networks will reduce investments and halt any progress we're making on creating new hi-tech jobs in our state. More regulation means less investment – and fewer jobs.
