On Monday, November 16, 2009, representatives of the applicants in the above-captioned proceeding met with Priya Aiyar, Legal Advisor for Wireline Competition and International Issues to Chairman Genachowski and Christine Kurth, Policy Director and Wireline Counsel to Commissioner McDowell. Present on behalf of the National Rural Utilities Cooperative Finance Corporation ("CFC") were Frank Vaughan, Assistant General Counsel of CFC, and Brita Strandberg of Wiltshire & Grannis LLP. Present on behalf of Stan Springel, Chapter 11 Trustee of the Bankruptcy Estate of Innovative Communication Corporation ("New ICC") were E. Clarke Garnett, President of Vitelco and COO of ICC, and Henry Rivera and Scott Delacourt of Wiley Rein LLP.

Applicants discussed issues consistent with their prior submissions in this proceeding. In particular, applicants provided background on CFC, New ICC, and the license holding entities, the bankruptcy process, and regulatory proceedings to date.
