
Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Sections 1.1206 and 1.1204(a)(10) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.1206 and 1.1204(a)(10), the undersigned, on behalf of the Nuclear Energy Institute ("NEI") exchanged emails on November 18, 2009 with Scot Stone, Deputy Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. In my email to Mr. Stone, I noted NEI's willingness to meet with the staff regarding NEI's our recent Waiver filing and asked him for an estimate of the timetable for FCC action, given the fact that the Experimental Licenses (the subject of the Waiver filing) expire on February 17, 2010, and that the plants require significant advance notice of changes associated with outage communication.

NEI is electronically filing this notice using the Commission's Electronic Filing System for inclusion in WT Docket No. 09-176 and ET Docket No. 05-345.
