Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, this letter is to inform the Commission that on Tuesday, September 17, the undersigned met with Chief Jamie Barnett, Deputy Chief David Furth, and Senior Legal Counsel Jeff Cohen, all of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau. Also in the meeting was Patrick Halley, NENA's Government Affairs Director. During the meeting we discussed NENA's comments in response to National Broadband Plan Public Notice # 8, submitted on November 12. We also discussed NENA's continued interest in action from the Commission on the issue of wireless 9-1-1 location accuracy and call-blocking capabilities for harassing non-service initialized 9-1-1 calls. Additionally, we discussed the broader challenge of accurate and automatic location capabilities for numerous current and emerging devices and applications that do not currently fit within the Commission's existing 9-1-1 rules.
