On behalf of Hiawatha Broadband Communications, Inc. ("Hiawatha") and Calix, and in response to your request of November 20, 2009¹ this letter provides authorization for the November 10, 2009 *ex parte* notification of Hiawatha and Calix to be included in GN Dockets 09-47 and 09-137.


