

I received a message on my Mobile Video Phone by Purple from the Executive Director of the PA Society for the Advancement of the Deaf, using his VP 200 by Sorenson. When I looked for the 10 digit phone number that were supposed to be displayed for returning the call, I found the ip address instead (68.xxx.xx.xx). I tried the ip address and fortunately the ip address had not changed in the interim and we were connected. I thought all brands of VP's were supposed to be able to connect via identifiable 10-digit numbers by Nov. 12 and that in accordance with FCC's functional equivalency regulations, the 10 digit numbers were supposed to be visible to all VP users regardless of the VP brand (VP200, MVP, CPU with P3; Z; Ojo, etc.) used by the caller and callee. Please look into this and take action to enforce this requirement. Hearing people are able to identify callers 10 digit numbers regardless of telephone brand being used.

This is the second time in less than a week that this has happen and I'm getting fed up with the failure of Sorenson to comply with Federal "Functional Equivalency" Regulations. Please enforce this requirement.
