On Wednesday, November 25, 2009, AT&T Inc. and Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Verizon Wireless”) (collectively the “Applicants”) filed a Request for a Second Protective Order in the above-referenced proceeding to provide heightened or second level protection of certain categories of highly sensitive competitive information that have been requested by the FCC in the General Information Request received by Applicants on November 19, 2009, to which responses are due to be filed today. Verizon Wireless understands that this request is still under consideration by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Earlier today, the undersigned counsel for Verizon Wireless spoke by telephone with Kathy Harris, Deputy Chief of the Mobility Division of the Bureau, indicating that Verizon Wireless would prefer that all pending protective order issues be resolved before they submit any highly confidential materials to the FCC to ensure that the appropriate protection will be provided the information as filed.

Accordingly, Verizon Wireless requests that it be given until one business day following grant of the Applicants’ request for a Second Protective Order in this proceeding to provide written responses to the November 19 General Information Request.
