On December 2, 2009, Michael D. Rosenthal and Holly Henderson of Southern Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a SouthernLINC Wireless (“SouthernLINC Wireless”), and David D. Rines of McDermott Will & Emery LLP met with David Goldman of the Office of Chairman Genachowski, and met separately with Ruth Milkman, Paul Murray, Nese Guendelsberger, and Christina Clearwater of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the Commission’s proceeding on the roaming obligations of commercial mobile radio service (CMRS) providers.

In these meetings, SouthernLINC Wireless discussed the status of the pending Petitions for Reconsideration in WT Docket No. 05-265 and urged the Commission to affirm its decision in its *2007 Roaming Order* to include push-to-talk (“PTT”) services within the scope of services covered by the Commission’s automatic roaming rule.

SouthernLINC Wireless also discussed the status of the Commission’s *Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in that docket and encouraged the Commission to take prompt action to make automatic roaming available for all mobile wireless data services upon request and on just, reasonable, and nondiscriminatory rates, terms, and conditions. The views and positions expressed by SouthernLINC Wireless were consistent with its filings in the record of this proceeding.
