The Public Safety Spectrum Trust Corporation ("PSST") hereby provides notice of permitted *ex parte* communications. On December 2, 2009, Chief Harlin R. McEwen, Chairman of the PSST, and Michele Farquhar of Hogan & Hartson LLP, counsel to the PSST, met in three separate meetings with Stagg Newman, Chief Technologist of the FCC's Omnibus Broadband Team; Angela Giancarlo, Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner McDowell; and Jeff Cohen, Senior Legal Counsel for the Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau.

The primary purpose of the meetings was to update the FCC representatives regarding public safety and D Block developments in recent weeks, including issues related to the FCC's ongoing national broadband plan proceeding and the early deployment waivers filed by some public safety entities. We also discussed issues related to the FCC's public/private partnership approach for the D Block, consistent with the PSST's prior filings in this proceeding, and the ongoing efforts by the public safety community to facilitate a nationwide, interoperable wireless broadband network.
