This is to inform you that, on December 3, 2009, Christopher Libertelli, Senior Director, Government and Regulatory Affairs – The Americas, Skype Communications, S.A.R.L. ("Skype"), and the undersigned met with Bruce Gottlieb, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor in the Office of Chairman Genachowski, Sharon Gillett, Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau, and Zachary Katz of the Office of Strategic Planning & Policy Analysis.

The topic of the meeting was the draft proposed rules for public input in Appendix A of the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the above-captioned dockets. We expressed our position that while the Commission's six principles of openness are appropriately stated generally so as to preserve innovation for all members of the broadband ecosystem, the Part 8 rules should include robust procedural mechanisms to enforce such rules. We also discussed ways in which the sixth principle of transparency might be implemented, including the types of information that broadband Internet access service providers should make publicly available.
