On Thursday, December 3, 2009, David Donovan, Victor Tawil and Bruce Franca of the Association for Maximum Service Television, Inc. (MSTV), met with Commissioner Meredith Atwell Baker. Members of Commissioner Baker's staff, Mr. Brad Gillen and Mr. Charles Matthias, were present as well.

We discussed some of the issues relating to broadcasting in the FCC's broadband initiative. We stated that broadcasters want to work with the Commission to help facilitate the deployment of broadband in the United States. However, some of the proposals would prevent local stations from offering HDTV, multicast and mobile television services. Specifically, we observed that rural broadband services could be accommodated with proper engineering. In addition, we noted that a significant number of cable and satellite systems rely on over-the-air television signals to access programming on their facilities.

No materials were distributed at this meeting.
