Yesterday, Dave Miller, Tom Sugrue and the undersigned, of T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”), met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and Louis Peraertz, the Commissioner’s Legal Advisor, to provide an introduction to T-Mobile and speak about issues relevant to the wireless industry, including T-Mobile’s views on the subjects covered in the above referenced dockets.

Specifically, we discussed the need to make more spectrum available for commercial broadband use. Furthermore, we highlighted the need for reasonably priced backhaul, especially in rural areas, in order to meet the Commission’s policy goals in regards to wireless broadband deployment. Additionally, we urged the Commissioner to support mandatory data roaming and the elimination of the “home market exclusion,” thus allowing customers access to the same broadband services while traveling as they have at home. Finally, we talked about the unique characteristics of wireless networks that require reasonable network management practices in order to ensure optimal customer experiences.
