The Connecticut Educators' Network ("CTEN") hereby petitions the Commission for a waiver of the E-Rate rules concerning the Form 479 requirements. Additionally, CTEN is requesting a review of the Administrator's Decision on Appeal for Form 471 Application Number 418822, Funding Request Number 1202237.

The Administrator's decision on appeal: Denied

According to the Administrator's Decision on Appeal dated November 5, 2009:

(Attachment 1) :

"According to our records, during the course of an audit it was determined that for Funding Year 2004, Connecticut Educators' Network (as head of the consortium) failed to collect the required FCC Forms 479 from the member entities, and the Consortium did not make certification on FCC Form 486 application number 286211 that the FCC Forms 479 were duly completed and signed. In accordance with the rules of the Schools and Libraries Division Support Mechanism, entities receiving discounts on Internet Access must be in compliance with the appropriate requirements of the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) on or before the date services begin. On the FCC Form 486 it was indicated that services began on July 1, 2004. You have failed on appeal to demonstrate that USAC erred in its decision to seek recovery of improperly disbursed funds. Consequently, your appeal is denied.

FCC rules require billed entities to certify on FCC Forms 486 that as of the date discounted services began, the recipients of service were in compliance with the appropriate requirements of CIPA in order to be eligible for discounts. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.520(b)(1), (c). Billed entities that fail to provide the certifications or that allow services to be delivered prior to compliance with the requirements of CIPA violate these rules. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.520(c). Billed entities that fail to ensure compliance with the requirements of CIPA must reimburse any funds and discounts they received

from the Schools and Libraries Support Mechanism for the period in which they were non-compliant. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.520(e).”

We are requesting a waiver of the Form 479 requirement for the consortium for FY 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006.

For FY 2003 and FY 2004, Forms 479 were collected at the September, 2003 meeting for the member districts. As stated in the appeal, the members left the funding year blank and the consortium leader entered “Year 6” instead of “2004” for the FY 2004 Forms 479. Additionally, the Form 486 filed by the consortium had item 11a. checked which states “the recipient (s) of service represented in the Funding Request Number (s) on this Form 486 has (have) complied with the requirements of the Children’s Internet Protection Act, as codified at 47 U.S.C. Sec 254(h) and (l)” instead of item 11d. “ I certify as the Billed Entity for the consortium that I have collected duly completed and signed Forms 479 from all eligible members of the consortium.”

The audit of the 2004-05 funding year was conducted after the consortium had dissolved, however, the auditors were able to verify that each member district was indeed in compliance with CIPA.

For FY 2005 and FY 2006, the Forms 479 were properly filled out (See Attachments 3 and 4), however the Form 486 for each year has item 11a. checked which states “the recipient (s) of service represented in the Funding Request Number (s) on this Form 486 has (have) complied with the requirements of the Children’s Internet Protection Act, as codified at 47 U.S.C. Sec 254(h) and (l)” instead of 11d. which was the correct choice for the consortium filing.


If the consortium had continued to file E-Rate applications, they had new procedures that were going to be put in place to ensure the Form 486 was correctly checked for Item 11d. and to ensure that the Forms 479 were properly completed and retained.

Since the consortium members were in compliance with CIPA each year, and they used their best efforts to properly complete the Form 479 each year, we are respectfully requesting a waiver of the Form 479 requirements for FY 2003 – Form 471 Applications

377697 and 377722, FY 2004- Form 471 Application # 418822, FY 2005- Form 471 Application # 482850, and FY 2006-Form 471 Application # 499511.

We are also requesting a review of the Administrator's Decision on Appeal for Form 471 Application Number 418822, FRN 1202237.

After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) has made its decision in regard to your appeal of USAC's Funding Year 2004 Notification of Improperly Disbursed Funds Letter for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of USAC's decision. The date of this letter begins the 60 day time period for appealing this decision to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). If your Letter of Appeal included more than one Application Number, please note that you will receive a separate letter for each application.

Explanation:

- According to our records, during the course of an audit it was determined that for Funding Year 2004, Connecticut Educators' Network (as head of the consortium) failed to collect the required FCC Forms 479 from the member entities, and the Consortium did not make certification on FCC Form 486 application number 286211 that the FCC Forms 479 were duly completed and signed. In accordance with the rules of the Schools and Libraries Division Support Mechanism, entities receiving discounts on Internet Access must be in compliance with the appropriate requirements of the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) on or before the date services begin. On the FCC Form 486 it was indicated that services began on July 1, 2004. You have failed on appeal to demonstrate that USAC erred in its decision to seek recovery of improperly disbursed funds. Consequently, your appeal is denied.

FCC rules require billed entities to certify on FCC Forms 486 that as of the date discounted services began, the recipients of service were in compliance with the appropriate requirements of CIPA in order to be eligible for discounts. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.520(b)(1), (c). Billed entities that fail to provide the certifications or that allow services to be delivered prior to compliance with the requirements of CIPA violate these rules. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.520(c). Dear Appeals Processor:

We are appealing the "Notification of Improperly Disbursed Funds Recovery Letter" dated August 26, 2009 (See Attachment A).

The disbursed funds recovery explanation states:

"After a thorough review, it has been determined that the funds were improperly disbursed on this funding request. An investigation revealed that the entities receiving service were not in compliance with the guidelines set forth by CIPA when these services began. In accordance with the rules of the Schools and Libraries Division Support Mechanism, entities receiving discounts on Internet Access or Internal Connections must be in compliance with the appropriate requirements of CIPA on or before the date services begin. On the Form 486 it was indicated that services began on 07/01/2004. However, during the course of an audit it was determined that no Form 479 from the member entities were collected by the consortium for funding year 2004 and the consortium did not make certification on the FCC Form 486 that the Form 479 were duly completed and signed. Accordingly, USAC will seek recovery of \$3,552.12 improperly disbursed funds for the period of non-compliance with CIPA."

In November, 2006, Connecticut Educators' Network was selected for a compliance attestation examination of FY 2004, Form 471 No. 418822, FRN 1202341. During the course of the audit, the auditors requested copies of the Forms 479 that the consortium leader had collected from the member entities in order to certify each member district's compliance with CIPA.

KELLOGG & SOVEREIGN® CONSULTING, LLC

Item # 2, "Funding Year," of the Forms 479 that were on file said "Year 6" for the year instead of "2004". This was a ministerial error on the part of the consortium leader as he had asked the member districts to complete the forms at a meeting held in September, 2003. The current funding year was 2003-04 (Year 6) and they were getting ready to file the E-Rate application for 2004-05 (Year 7). Even though the applicant explained the situation to the auditor(s), they still listed non-compliance of the Form 479 as a finding. The auditors also wrote in their findings that due to non-compliance of the Form 479, the entire amount of the funding request or \$118,046.34 could be recommended for recovery.

It is our understanding that the auditors conducted alternative tests to determine that the member districts were indeed in compliance with CIPA even though the Forms 479 did not say "2004" in block 2 of the form.

After USAC reviewed the audit findings and supporting documentation, USAC did not request recovery of funds due to non-compliance with the Form 479 (CIPA certification).

The only amount recovered by USAC as a result of the audit on FRN 1202341 was \$960.00. The \$960.00 amount recovered was related to the audit findings that the applicant did not pay the entire non-discounted portion (amount due \$132.00) and funds were disbursed for products and/or services that were not delivered (amount due from service provider \$837.00).

Since the consortium members were in compliance with CIPA for FY 2004-05 even though they incorrectly completed item 2 of the Form 479, we respectfully request that the funding on FRN 1202237 remain funded in full as originally approved.

Our routine review of Schools and Libraries Program (Program) funding commitments has revealed certain applications where funds were disbursed in violation of Program rules.

In order to be sure that no funds are used in violation of Program rules, the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) must now recover these improper disbursements. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the recoveries as required by Program rules, and to give you an opportunity to appeal this decision. USAC has determined the applicant is responsible for all or some of the Program rule violations. Therefore, the applicant is responsible to repay all or some of the funds disbursed in error.

This is NOT a bill. The next step in the recovery of improperly disbursed funds process is for USAC to issue you a Demand Payment Letter. The balance of the debt will be due within 30 days of that letter. Failure to pay the debt within 30 days from the date of the Demand Payment Letter could result in interest, late payment fees, administrative charges and implementation of the "Red Light Rule." The FCC's Red Light Rule requires USAC to dismiss pending FCC Form 471 applications if the entity responsible for paying the outstanding debt has not paid the debt, or otherwise made satisfactory arrangements to pay the debt within 30 days of the notice provided by USAC. The Capitol Region Education Council (CREC) hereby submits its response to KPMG's audit findings:

Application Matters – Findings

#1 - Technology Plan – Approval

Condition: Six member entities in the Consortium (Granby School District, Plainville School District, Stonington School District, Suffield School District, Vernon School District and Weston Public Schools) did not have their technology plans approved prior to the submission of the FCC Form 470 on 12/20/2003.

Response: In all future filings, prior to filing the Form 470, the consortium leader will request copies of technology plans covering the next funding year.

#2 – Discount Calculation – Other Issues

Condition: CEN included two entities (Xavier High School and Stamford School District) that did not submit Letters of Agency (LOA) in its discount calculation. If those two entities had not been included, the discount percentage should have been 39%.

Response: In all future filings, the Beneficiary will only include entities that have submitted LOA's in the FCC 471.

#3 – FCC Form 479

Condition: No FCC Forms 479 from the member entities were collected by CEN for FY 2004 and CEN did not make certifications on FCC Form 486 that the FCC Forms 479 were duly completed and signed.

Response: The Beneficiary collected the Forms 479 for FY 2004 – 2005 at a September 3, 2003 meeting of the Connecticut Educators' Network. The forms were signed and dated by all entities, however, they left the funding year block blank. On the Form 479, item 2 block, the Beneficiary filled in "Year 6" for the funding year instead of the correct notation of "2004".

We request that USAC view the confusion on the funding year as a clerical error. There has been considerable confusion in the E-Rate program filing community over the naming of the funding years. For the first four years of the program, SLD referred to the years by the program year number. In the fifth year of the program, SLD started referencing the beginning year instead of the program year number. So for the funding year 2002-03, the reference for the year was "2002." However, the accounting profession uses the ending year to reference fiscal years.

Since the funding year is not in the format required by the instructions, one has to rely on the date the form was signed as well as further information within the form to support the beneficiary's statement that this form was for FY 2004-05. In the text on page 2, "item e" of the Form, there is text referencing funding year 2004. Additionally, the form was signed during the appropriate period of time for the consortium to be starting its planning for E-Rate FY 2004-05.

In all future filings, the Beneficiary will collect all FCC Forms 479 from all entities for each funding year and make certifications on FCC Form 486 that the FCC Forms 479 were completed and signed.

#4 – Letter of Agency

Condition: Two entities (Stamford School District and Xavier High School) on Block 4 of FCC Form 471 could not provide any Letters of Agency (LOA). Additionally, one entity (CT Center for School Change) that was not listed in Block 4, but received funding, could not provide a LOA either.

Granby School District signed LOA after the FCC form 471 was postmarked.

Response: In all future filings, the Beneficiary will retain Letters of Agency from the entities, signed and dated prior to the certification postmark date of the Form 471. The disbursement of \$960.57 made on behalf of CT Center for School Change will be voluntarily refunded.

Receipt of Service and Reimbursement Matters – Findings

#5 – Service Provider Billing

Condition: The service provider bills only supported E-Rate disbursement of \$118,169.20, while total net disbursement was \$119,006.34. There was a discrepancy of \$837.14.

Response: In the future, Beneficiary and the service provider will reconcile the amount billed to the Beneficiary and the amount invoiced to USAC for accuracy. The difference of \$837.14 will be voluntarily refunded.

#6 – Entities not on Block 4 of FCC Form 471

Condition: Among all 13 entities that received E-Rate funding, CT Center for School Change, Plainville School District, and Suffield School District were not included on Block 4 of FCC Form 471.

Response: E-Rate discounts were issued for Plainville and Suffield for the following reasons: a) both entities were clearly listed on the proposal included on the Item 21 attachment for this funding request which was approved by SLD, b) CREC was listed on the Block 4 and both Plainville and Suffield were members of CREC and therefore organizationally fell under CREC, and c) Both entities provided signed LOA's to the consortium leader. In all future filings, the Beneficiary will ensure that all entities receiving funding will be included on Block 4 of FCC Form 471.

#7 – Document Retention Issues

Condition: The Beneficiary did not maintain all its E-Rate related documents for a period of five years.

Response: The Beneficiary will require all entities to keep all E-Rate related documents in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission Fifth Report and Order (FCC 04-190 released August 13, 2004) for a period of five years after the last day of service delivered for a particular funding year.

We request the following background information be taken into consideration:

1. Connecticut Educators' Network

The Connecticut Educators' Network was formed in May, 2002 by Capitol Region Education Council (CREC). CREC is a regional educational service center located in Hartford, Connecticut. CREC determined that its member school districts could receive Internet Access for a lower price if they went out for bid as a group. The CEN network was successful at securing Internet Access services at a lower cost which resulted in less funding requested from E-Rate and a reduction in the percentage each school had to pay. With the addition of E-Rate funding they were able to afford the advanced Internet Access services. This E-Rate filing is an excellent example of E-Rate funds being used as intended by the statute. The E-Rate funding enabled these districts to provide their students with broadband Internet Access services which they could not have otherwise afforded.

The Connecticut Educators Network's funding request number 1202341 for Internet Access Services provided by Advanced Corporate Networking (dba Digital Back Office) is an

excellent example of the use of E-Rate funds for school districts to obtain access to discounted information services. CREC did an excellent job of organizing the group, and the member districts made the extra effort to participate in this consortium filing. As a result of this audit, CREC has identified ways in which it can more effectively administer the E-Rate program for its members and ensure full compliance with program rules. CREC is committed to resolving the issues identified by the auditors and has already begun to implement its own internal controls and the recommendations provided by KPMG.

2. The Bishop Perry Decision and Purpose of E-Rate Audits and Investigations.

One of the most significant changes in the Universal Service Discount Mechanism for Schools and Libraries ("E-Rate") is a more applicant friendly approach brought about by the FCC's decision in the Request for Review of the Decision of the Universal Service Administrator by Bishop Perry Middle School (FCC 06-54, Released May 19, 2006). In the Bishop Perry decision (Paragraph I.2), the administrator stated:

[M]any E-Rate program beneficiaries, particularly small entities, contend that the application process is complicated, resulting in a significant number of applications for E-Rate support being denied for ministerial, clerical or procedural errors. We find that the actions we take here to provide relief from these types of errors in the application process will promote the statutory requirements of Section 254(h) of the Communications Act of 1934 as amended (the Act) by helping to ensure that eligible schools and libraries actually obtain access to discounted telecommunications and information services. In particular, we believe that by directing USAC to modify certain application processing procedures and granting a limited waiver of our application filing rules, we will provide for a more effective application processing system that will ensure eligible schools and libraries will be able to realize the intended benefits of the E-Rate program as we consider additional steps to reform and improve the E-Rate program.

With the new applicant friendly approach, the Administrator in the Bishop Perry decision now requires USAC to provide all E-Rate applicants with the opportunity to cure ministerial or clerical errors that are made during the application process. Applicants now enjoy a fifteen day grace period to revise or correct such errors after notification by USAC of potential or actual errors or omissions. These new rules are meant to ensure that the original benefits contemplated by Congress in implementing the E-Rate program can actually be enjoyed by applicants that have made innocent errors during the application process. As the commission stated in the Bishop Perry Decision, "section 254 [47 U.S.C. § 254(h)] directs the Commission to 'enhance . . . access to advanced telecommunications and information services for all public and non-profit elementary and secondary school classrooms, health care providers and libraries.'" By relaxing the strict application of procedural rules to allow the correction of ministerial or clerical errors, deserving applicants can take full advantage of the financial benefits offered through the E-Rate program, in instances where minor deviations are identified but do not amount to a finding of waste, fraud or abuse. In the instant matter, CREC asserts that the minor inadvertent procedural deviations identified

during the audit should be excused such that its member schools can retain the financial benefits of the E-Rate funds provided during funding year 2004-2005 since no waste, fraud or abuse was found by the auditors in connection with the minor procedural deviations.

3. The Beneficiary will voluntarily offer to refund \$1,797.71 and begin implementing the recommendations from the audit findings immediately.

CREC would like to thank Mr. Yu and the KPMG audit team for their hard work and diligence in assisting USAC with the task of auditing the universal service discount mechanism. The audit findings of audits over previous years of the program have brought to light weaknesses in the program which have resulted in significant improvements in the administration of the program, better rules and more helpful guidance for the program participants.

Our routine review of Schools and Libraries Program funding commitments has revealed certain applications where funds were disbursed in violation of program rules.

In order to be sure that no funds are used in violation of program rules, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) must now recover these improper disbursements. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the recoveries as required by program rules, and to give you an opportunity to appeal this decision. USAC has determined the applicant is responsible for all or some of the program rule violations. Therefore, the applicant is responsible to repay all or some of the funds disbursed in error.

Disbursed Funds Recovery Explanation:

After a thorough investigation, it has been determined that funds were improperly disbursed on this funding request. During the course of an audit, it was determined that the applicant did not pay the entire non-discounted portion. FCC rules require applicants to pay the non-discount portion of the cost of the products or services purchased with universal service discounts. Applicants that do not pay the non-discount portion more than 90 days after completion of services have violated this rule. Consequently, the program rules have been violated. Accordingly, USAC is seeking recovery of \$123.00 (amount disbursed less the amount the applicant is eligible to receive based on the amount of the non-discounted portion that was paid), which was improperly disbursed from the applicant.

In addition, it was determined that funds were disbursed for products and/or services that were not delivered. Specifically, the applicant invoiced USAC in excess of the amount billed and services provided by the service provider. FCC rules authorize USAC to disburse funds to service providers for providing supported services to eligible entities. These rules are violated if the Administrator is invoiced and funds are disbursed in excess of the services and/or products delivered to the eligible entity. Therefore, USAC has determined that both the applicant and the service provider is responsible for this rule violation. Accordingly, USAC will seek recovery of the \$837.00 of improperly disbursed funds from both the applicant and the service provider.
