Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 16, 2009, William D. Wallace, Senior Counsel for Verizon Wireless, and the undersigned met with the following OET staff to discuss a Petition for Rulemaking filed by the “700 MHz A Block Good Faith Purchasers Alliance”: Julius Knapp (Chief), Walter Johnston, Geraldine Matise, and Hugh Van Tuyl.

The points we raised in this meeting were consistent with Verizon Wireless’ filings in the above-captioned proceedings. In particular, we noted that the Petitioners’ claim that Verizon Wireless has somehow manipulated the standards process to prevent equipment from being manufactured to operate on Lower A Block spectrum is patently false. We urged the FCC to reject the Petitioners’ requests to initiate a rulemaking proceeding and suspend the certification of 700 MHz equipment until such a proceeding is resolved. A grant of the Petitioners’ requests would interfere with the competitive wireless marketplace, impede the development of 700 MHz equipment, and delay the deployment of wireless broadband services.
