On December 23, 2009, Jesse Caulfield, President and CEO, Key Bridge Global LLC, met with Blair Levin, Coordinator of the Commission's National Broadband Plan.

We discussed spectrum management, monitoring, inventory and use, Key Bridge's spectrum sensing capabilities, related information services, plus the utility of empirical measurements to validate radio coverage and propagation estimates. I also briefed Mr. Levin on Key Bridge's TV bands database and spectrum monitoring field trials.

With regard to ET Docket 04-186, Key Bridge is a Virginia company and candidate for FCC authorization to administer a TV bands database. We have made several important contributions to the Docket that support an open, interoperable and competitive marketplace, assures consistent incumbent protections across multiple database administrators, and seeks to maximize consumer convenience. Key Bridge is presently field-testing our operational TV bands database system and related services.
