CPNI Compliance Operating Procedures

New York Telsave, Inc. ("the company") provides local dial tone service primarily to payphone service providers through a wholesale agreement with the incumbent LEC.

The company employs three employees that have access to the information and all are trained as to when they are and are not authorized to use CPNI. Company personnel are trained that CPNI may be used only in the provision of telecommunications service. Company personnel may also use CPNI to initiate, render, bill and collect for the telecommunication services provided to the customer. The company's personnel may use, disclose, or permit access to CPNI for the purpose providing or maintaining service offerings among the types of service that the customer subscribes to without customer approval. CPNI may be released upon issuance of a law enforcement or court subpoena requesting CPNI information after being verified and a copy of the subpoena shall be kept on file for reference.

In cases where a breach of CPNI is found or if a complaint is received, an officer of the company shall investigate the claim and take the necessary disciplinary action starting with verbal reprimands, escalating to a notation in the record and if continued, possible suspension or termination.

The company does not engage in sales and marketing campaigns of any sort and therefore, there is no risk of the customer's CPNI being disclosed or provided to third parties. The company does not engage in any marketing and therefore a review regarding carrier compliance with the rules is unnecessary. If, in the future, a marketing plan is developed that utilizes a customer's CPNI, a system for obtaining the customer's approval and monitoring of such a program will be clearly established prior to the implementation.
