Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of QUALCOMM Incorporated (“Qualcomm”), this is to report that on Friday, January 8, 2010, Dr. Paul Jacobs, Don Rosenberg, Peggy Johnson and I met with FCC Commissioner Robert McDowell and Christine Kurth of Commissioner McDowell’s staff. During the meeting, we provided background information on various mobile broadband technologies, products, and services. In addition, consistent with Qualcomm’s prior pleadings concerning the National Broadband Plan, we reiterated the need for the identification, allocation, and auction of additional licensed spectrum to meet the exponential growth in usage of mobile broadband. Finally, we urged the Commission not to regulate wireless network management, i.e., not to apply the rules proposed in the Commission’s pending Notice of Proposed Rule Making to wireless, because of the pressing need for wireless network operators to conserve scarce wireless bandwidth and to incentivize others to do so for the benefit of all consumers, in light of the inherently limited capacity of wireless networks and the burgeoning growth in usage of, and demand for, wireless applications and services.
