

The American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) is a trade organization representing the agency or department within each of the 50 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico responsible for the construction and maintenance of America's highway and road system. AASHTO is also an FCC authorized Frequency Advisory Committee (FAC) coordinating license applications within the shared Specialized Mobile Radio pool included in the American Automobile Association's (AAA) request.

AASHTO supports the request of AAA. However, as the authorization requested by AAA includes frequencies subject to assignment to Public Safety agencies, AASHTO requests if the AAA be granted authorization it be conditioned on AAA agreeing to abide by the Memorandum of Agreement signed by all FACs outlining the intercoordinator notification procedure for vacated spectrum frequency assignments.
