This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on January 12, 2010, Chris Riley of Free Press met with Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis.

We discussed issues related to the Commission's open proceedings on wireless competition and truth-in-billing and disclosure of information concerning wireless and broadband Internet Access services. We reiterated arguments in our jointly filed comments and reply comments in docket 09-66 to emphasize the impact of roaming regulations, early termination fees, exclusive handset deals, disproportionate spectrum holdings, high special access costs, consolidation, and other factors on the state of competition in the wireless market. We discussed our suggestions, as filed in comments and reply comments in dockets 09-158, 98-170, and 04-36, for additional disclosure of information needed by consumers to ensure transparency in selecting and using wireless and Internet access services, to maximize any benefits that could be gained from limited competition and from regulatory reforms to increase competition, and to protect consumers from unexpected charges or service limitations.
