This letter will notify the Commission that on January 12, 2009, Kathleen Grillo and Howard Woolley of Verizon and Jerry Karnick and John Scott of Verizon Wireless met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, and Rick Kaplan, Angela Kronenburg and Louis Peraertz of the Commissioner's staff. Mr. Karnick reviewed Verizon Wireless' current policies as to early termination fees (ETFs), and responded to questions from the Commissioner and her staff about ETFs and how they are disclosed to customers. Mr. Karnick's statements were consistent with the statements in Verizon's December 18, 2009 letter to the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau, which provided information about Verizon Wireless' ETF policies for customers who choose to purchase service under a term contract.
