Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 13, 2010, David Ellen of Cablevision Systems Corporation (“Cablevision”) spoke by telephone with Austin Schlick, FCC general counsel, regarding the above-captioned dockets.

Mr. Ellen argued that a presumption of harm arising from an MVPD’s lack of access to a terrestrially-delivered regional sports network (“RSN”) finds no statutory or decisional support where the MVPD has access to the games shown on that RSN in standard definition. He also pointed out the substantive and procedural flaws with the customer survey commissioned by Verizon in connection with its pending program access complaint against Cablevision and filed in the instant proceeding, as more fully set out in Cablevision’s other filings in the above-captioned dockets yesterday.
