Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 13, 2010, Michael Wilner, Chairman and CEO of Insight Communications and I met with Chairman Genachowski along with Sherrese Smith, David Goldman, Bill Lake and Colin Crowell of the Chairman's staff.

In this meeting, Mr. Wilner gave an overview of Insight's company profile and discussed broadly several issues impacting Insight, as well as the cable industry generally. In terms of broadband deployment, he encouraged the Commission to focus on adoption programs, such as the A+ Program endorsed by the cable industry. On the issue of set top boxes, Mr. Wilner suggested that the Commission adopt an all-MVPD solution. Mr. Wilner also addressed the issues relating to Network Neutrality and stressed the importance of giving the industry as much flexibility as possible to manage their networks and that the rules should apply to all platforms. He also discussed generally issues relating to program access and retransmission consent.
