

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206 of the FCC's rules, that yesterday, George Mahoney, Vice President, Secretary, and General Counsel of Media General, Inc. ("Media General), and I met with William T. Lake, Chief of the Media Bureau; Jennifer Tatel, Chief of the Industry Analysis Division of the Media Bureau; and Mania Baghdadi, Deputy Chief of the Industry Analysis Division of the Media Bureau, to discuss the financial downturn in the media sector and the status of the 2010 Quadrennial Review process. Mr. Mahoney also described various new initiatives for providing local news and content that the company is offering or plans to offer soon such as "7pm News with Twitter" and Mobile DTV applications. Because of Media General's emphasis on delivering local news, Mr. Mahoney also reviewed how its television stations have become the "political crossroads" of their communities. Mr. Mahoney also briefly discussed the positions set forth in comments Media General has submitted in connection with development of the National Broadband Plan.
